Assignment 12

Eternal Life is for Ever

Ecclesiastes 3:14

I know that, whatsoever God doeth, it shall be for ever: nothing can be put to it, nor any thing taken from it: and God doeth it, that men should fear before him.

Rules of the Memory Course

1. Memorize each assignment in the order given.
2. Memorize the assignment heading with each assignment.
3. Memorize the Bible references (the locations of the verses in the Bible) with each verse or group of verses.
4. Memorize the verses as they are printed. Do not add, change or leave out any words.
5. You are expected to memorize the assignment during the first part of the week and to use the rest of the week for review. If you wait until the end of the week to memorize, you will forget the verse too quickly, and this is not considered satisfactory work.
6. We suggest that you recite Saturday morning. If you cannot recite at this time, another time during the week may be agreed upon but you should recite at the same time each week throughout the memory course.
7. In reciting give the heading, reference, and then the verse or verses under the reference. Where verses come together, you may give one reference for all.
8. You must recite an entire assignment at one time, not just part of an assignment.
9. You are permitted to recite more than one assignment on the first recitation day, but after that, you may recite only one assignment a week, as you need to spend a full week on each assignment.
10. You should memorize well so that you do not need to be prompted in your recitation. It is a poor recitation if you have to be prompted more the four times. When this happens you should realize that you will need to spend more time learning your other assignments.

11. If you do not learn your assignments, your supervisor will have to disqualify you from the memory course. In case of emergency you should explain your problem to your supervisor.
12. If you drop behind one week, continue behind. Do not try to catch up by learning two assignments in one week.

Guide for Memorizing

1. You are doing a very big thing, and one that requires real effort. Memorizing the verses in this book means a great accomplishment. Ask God to help you.
2. Look up the verses to be memorized in your Bible, and read the whole passage where the verses are found. This will help you to understand the thought and remember the reference.
3. Read the whole assignment through carefully, including the heading and references.
4. Enjoy the Word of God. There's nothing better. Relax and work diligently at it. You are to memorize the verses of each assignment during the first part of the week, and then spend the rest of the week reviewing them. You are not doing acceptable work if you wait until the latter part of the week to begin memorizing.
5. Maintain for yourself a high standard. Note the smallest mistakes you make as you memorize. Learn accurately. Do not stop with anything short of perfect work. Do not try to get by with shoddy memory work.
6. When you memorize, you must put your mind on it and concentrate. You can't play or listen to the radio and memorize at the same time.

7. Frequent repetition and continual review are the secret of memorizing. Just keep at it in short periods at all times. Work on it with a purpose and enjoyment, not just dwelling on it in meaningless drudgery. Ask different members of the family or friends to follow the Memory Book while you review the verses. Two or three times will not be enough. It must be over and over again.
8. Establish close connection between the verses and your daily joys and problems. Use the verses in conversation, in prayer, in meditation, in witnessing, and in writing letters.
